In the shattered country of Cameroon, the performers dance their rage of living and the hope of possibilities, with the determination of they who have escaped from the worst. Zora Snake, who shook up the Liège Festival in 2019 with his performance Transfrontalier, is back with two intense performances: Shadow Survivors and L'Opéra du Villageois (see page 5). A choreographer, hip-hop dancer and performer, Zora Snake is one of the most talented artists on the Cameroonian scene today. Through every one of his deeply committed performances, he strives to counter the absurd prejudices and destructive ideologies of our time. Shadow Survivors is a "danced speech" about the daily life of countries and peoples in the throes of war. It is a collective invitation to reflect on our future social relations and our realities, to question our relationships, and, through dance and performance, to envision another possible world ruled by cohabitation and dialogue.
