Two actors invite us to visit the Tervuren museum. They raise the issue of the decolonisation of ethnographic museums and of the restitution of stolen African heritage: a complex and sensitive debate where dialogue endeavours to supplant the battle of wills.

Meticulously informed, they pass on their questions, multiple suggestions for answers, sometimes poetic, sometimes fictional and offbeat, sometimes historical.

Tervuren seizes this burning issue in a theatrical manner as an attempt to create new artistic narratives that unlock the imagination and encourage debate.
